#### Boss of G-Men Blasts

#### Myth That Most Criminals are Aliens

New York (WNS)—The myth fostered by alien-haters that aliens are responsible for the bulk of American crime was punctured by no less an authority than J. Edgar Hoover, chief of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, when he pointed out that America's most notorious criminals are all 100 per cent Americans. Mr. Hoover categorically denied the assertions of immigration restrictionists and cited the names of John Dillinger, "Baby Face" Nelson, Harvey Bailey, "Machine Gun" Kelly and many others to show that the leading public enemies are not aliens.

#### Proposes France Erect Monument to Dreyfus

Paris (WNS)—Erection of a monument in honor of the late Captain Alfred Dreyfus, victim of the celebrated Dreyfus Affair, is urged upon the government by the newspaper, L'Œuvre. The words "No more Dreyfus Affaires" should be on the monument, the paper declares, adding that it should be erected in front of the War Office.

### NAOMI JACOB REFUSES AWARD

#### Rejects Prize Because Hitler is Other Recipient

New York (WNS)—Naomi Jacob, noted novelist, has rejected an important award, the Eichelberger Prize, because the other of the two recipients for the current year is Adolf Hitler, it was revealed here. Miss Jacob, who is half Jewish, explained that "it was impossible for me to accept an award which was given to me and to Herr Hitler, because of the terrible persecution, the monstrous injustices and the abominable cruelties which are even now being laid upon the Jewish race in Germany."

### JUDAEAN CONCLAVE SHOWS NEW SPIRIT

#### Two Local Judaeans Elected to Board

The Twenty-Eighth Annual Convention of Young Judea held in New Orleans truly demonstrated the remarkable growth of the movement and its fine influence on the hundreds of young men and women who gathered from all parts of the country to participate in its deliberations. This Convention has the distinction of having had the largest attendance of many years. Eleven out of twelve organized regions were represented. Among those elected to the National Governing Board were Miss Harriet W. Wannerman and Joseph Keller, of Providence. There was evident a new spirit—a desire to have a closer contact with youth movements in general and to express themselves on the social and economic problems of the day.

So-called Jewish liberals, who see in Communism the only solution to the Jewish problem, were scathingly rebuffed by Rabbi Samuel Blumenfeld of Chicago in his message at the Installation Banquet. He particularly singled out "four radical young people" who, he said, have lost faith in humanity and its ideals and place their faith in Soviet Russia and the new economic order. Resolutions were adopted by the Convention for the acceptance of an annual budget of \$21,000 to cover the many departments and \$1,000 for the Keren Haanoar project (Scouting in Palestine) through direct contributions from the clubs; individual club membership dues were increased to 50 cents which will be applied towards a subscription to the Young Judaeans Magazine.

#### Lindbergh Visits Hitler

#### Will View Airplane Factories On Trip to Germany

Berlin (WNS)—Charles A. Lindbergh, America's number one aviator, has accepted an invitation to visit Germany as the guest of the Nazi regime. The flyer is due here on July 21st and will be entertained by Chancellor Hitler and officials of the propaganda ministry. During his stay in Germany Lindbergh will visit airplane factories, the Olympic village and airports.

#### Says Palestine Jews Have Self-Defense Corps

New York (WNS)—A Jewish self-defense corps of 50,000, with branches in every colony, has been organized in Palestine, a London dispatch to the Jewish Morning Journal declares. The dispatch, based on a statement of the Jerusalem correspondent of the London News-Chronicle, says that the Palestine guerrilla corps, of the existence of the corps, and that its members are armed with rifles, machine guns, grenades and bombs. Many of the Jewish colonies are equipped with tractors which could easily be converted into armed tanks. The News-Chronicle correspondent says that it is exaggerated, but adds that the Jewish colonies are prepared to defend themselves.

#### Estonia Considers Curb on Shechita

Tallinn, Estonia (WNS)—The Estonian government is preparing a law which will prohibit Jews from processing meat according to the Jewish ritual in restaurants beyond those needed to supply the Jewish population. The impending law is modeled on a similar act passed in Poland several weeks ago.

### VIENNA PAPER WARNS OF DANGER

#### Jews Forced to Support 65,000 Destitutes

Vienna (WNS)—The unconcealed fear of Austrian Jewry that the Austro-German rapprochement presages increased difficulties for them, if not official anti-Semitic legislation, was given formal expression by Die Stimme, leading Jewish weekly publication, when it warned the Jewish population that serious dangers are in the offing. "We have to reckon principally with the psychological effect on internal Austrian conditions of this agreement with Nazi Germany," the Stimme declares. Already the economic situation of the Jews, thanks to the process of driving them out of business and commercial life, which has been progressing for a couple of years, is forcing our Jewish community in Vienna alone to support 65,000 destitute persons. The impoverishment of these Vienna Jews is increasing alarmingly. In an effort to allay Jewish anxiety, M. Ludwig, head of the government press bureau, told foreign Jewish correspondents that the Austro-German pact will not affect the Jews at all, and that Austrian Jewry has no cause for alarm.

#### Tragedy Hits Family of Sweepstake Winner

New York (WNS)—The family of Morris Gold, young Polish-born Jewish baker who was the envy of millions in 1935 when he won \$143,000 in the Irish Sweepstakes, has learned that wealth does not necessarily bring happiness. A year after he won the big prize Gold took sick and died. His baby is ill, and his young widow is frantic, believing that the prize money has brought her bad luck.

### Racial Issue in Campaign Rapped by Missouri Rabbis

Topeka, Kan. (WNS)—"Both candidates of the major parties are free from anti-Semitism and other prejudices based on race and religion," it was declared in a joint statement issued by two Jewish leaders from Kansas and Missouri after a visit to Governor Alfred M. Langston, Rabbi Samuel Mayerberg of Kansas City, Mo., and Joseph Cohen, attorney of Kansas City, Kan., made this announcement, which is regarded as a reply to whispered charges.

The statement reads in part: "Race and religious issues have no place in this campaign. They are un-American and are raised purely for the purpose of appealing to the baser instincts of prejudice and bigotry. Both candidates of the major parties are free from anti-Semitism and other prejudices based on race and religion. Jews and Gentiles alike should choose their candidates on the basis of the candidates' stand on the great national issues confronting this nation at this time."

founded 49 years ago and turned anti-Semitic only recently, quotes its "special correspondent" at Providence, R. I., as the authority for the "plot." According to this correspondent, who claims to have attended the convention of the Zionist organization of America at Providence, he learned of the "plot" at the Z. O. A. convention. This correspondent declares that the Zionists were given complete instructions for the beginning of the revolution "on their New Year day." He regales readers of the Highland Post by "revealing" that President Roosevelt, "as the price of Governor Lehman's consenting to run again," promised to aid the plot with government funds and arms and agreed to allow Governor Lehman to be the ruler of America.

The correspondent called on "all true Americans" to "think fast, men! Think fast, mothers of our America, Franklin D. Roosevelt, in his hate and fear and sickness, has sold his American to the international plotters. Let this "plot" story fall to arouse readers of the Highland Post, the correspondent tells how he saw a young man by the name of Blumenthal, in Providence, shoot a Christian boy with a borrowed gun. This, the correspondent says, shows "what we Americans can expect when Rabbi Wise and Governor Lehman will rule."

#### U. S. Consul Protests

#### Arrest of American Who Called Streicher a Scoundrel

Berlin (WNS)—The American consul-general in Berlin is endeavoring to obtain the release of Ludwig Hoffman, German-born naturalized American citizen, who has been arrested in Nuremberg, capital of Nazi anti-Semitism, for allegedly insulting Julius Streicher, Germany's most notorious Jew-hater. Hoffman, who was arrested on July 1st, is said to have cried "Streicher is a scoundrel."

#### Anti-Nazi Clergy Protest Anti-Semitism to Hitler

Berlin (WNS)—Vigorous opposition to Nazi anti-Semitism and racial theories and to the attempts to defile Hitler are voiced in a 4,000-word letter of protest drafted by ten of the most militant anti-Nazi Protestant preachers, who are threatening to circulate the document secretly among millions of their followers unless the government replies to it immediately.

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### CONTRACT BRIDGE

#### The Takeout Double (Cont.)

Let us assume today that you are in third position, that your partner has opened the bidding and second hand has doubled. What is your procedure as partner of the opening bidder? If the first two bids are true, then we have already accounted for about six honor tricks, and therefore your maximum holding is about two to two honor tricks. We will divide the discussion into two cases depending on the type of opening bid.

#### Case 1

The opening bid of One No Trump by your partner has been doubled. You will respond as follows depending on your holding. With about two honor tricks you will REHOULDE. This response asks your partner (the original bidder) to double for penalties any response fourth hand may make, and if he cannot see fit to do that, he must pass (he should not make any rebid) if up to third hand (you) for action.

You will now double for penalties, or if inadvisable for some reason, will make some sort of bid in your longest suit, but in almost all cases if fourth hand, which should be void of honor strength under these circumstances.

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sticks in a bid, he will get socked for penalties.

With about 1 plus honor trick you will PASS unless you hold a long suit (preferably a major) in which case you may takeout. The pass however, on the bid made by fourth hand.

But holding less than one honor trick you should takeout in a five card or longer suit. This bid will indicate for play in a suit and for part score only. It may also hinder opponents from getting together.

#### Case 2

When the doubled bid was one of a suit.

1. Redouble with about 2½ HT or with 2 HT divided amongst the three unbid suits.

2. RAISE once if holding the requirements of a shaded single raise, (i. e. proceed as though there was no intervening double); raise twice with four or more trumps and four playing tricks regardless of honor strength. These raises will be construed by partner that your hand is of value only at the suit originally mentioned and will interfere with your opponents getting together.

3. Takeout in a new suit with 1½ HT and a hiddable suit.

4. Make a FORCING TAKEOUT (bid one more than necessary in a new suit) with unbalanced distribution (a good long suit) and no hope of profitable penalty, but a sure game on your side. This bid does not show 3½ HT (as previously required for forcing takeouts) but is made with weakness in partner's suit where a redouble would be left in.

5. Bid one No trump with 1½ HT and no hiddable suit.

6. Otherwise use the most eloquent bid in bridge, PASS.

#### Read This Over

Today's lesson is rather comprehensive and should be studied diligently. Occasions for proper responses by third hand over an intervening double occur very frequently and full use of opportunities thus presented should be made use of by careful players.

### Funds Will Maintain Hillel Foundation Work

The work of the Anti-Defamation League, which was founded in 1913, exposes all anti-semitic movements as essentially un-American and vicious and counteracts all scurrilous literatures by bringing, in a constructive manner, the truth about Jews and Judaism to the general community.

In charge of the drive in the local district is David Falk, president of the Providence B'nai B'rith, Max J. Rosenzhrn, co-chairman, and Charles Silverman, co-chairman, who is acting as treasurer.

### Pleads for Soldier Who Killed His Son

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—Asserting that "we of the stricken family will not find consolation for our lost son by the punishment of the British soldier whose bullet accidentally struck him," the father of Adam Lipkin, the 22-year-old railway employee who was shot dead while investigating a traffic accident, sent a plea to the Colonel of the Cheshire regiment urging leniency for the soldier who is being held responsible for his death.

### World Jewish Congress

On the eve of their departure for Geneva, the American delegates to the World Jewish Congress apparently have been given the mandate to represent United States Jewry. Such should rightly be the situation.

Prior to the selection of the delegates a small group of well meaning people were of the opinion that a congress at this time would be most disastrous because of its effect upon our fellow Jews in troubled lands. Repression were feared in more liberal lands.

#### No Representation

Others thought that they did not want to be represented. Their arguments, of course, are the weaker. It is as though we are against a democracy because being a member of a minority we do not want to be ruled by the majority. Happily, this group is made up of a very small number.

The congress has attempted to be as democratic as possible. It has sought to be representative of the entire cross section of Jewry. True, its method of selecting representatives could have been much stronger. Yet, with all of its faults and weaknesses, it truly speaks for the greatest majority of Jews in the past several hundred years.

#### Local Indifference

If any one is to blame for any short-sightedness, that blame may fall in our own back yards (in every community). We are members of a local organization. That organization is a member of the local unit of the American Jewish Congress. And when matters of importance arise in the Congress, we pass them off with indifference and "let Tom or Jerry do it".

## READERS SCORE SEGAL'S OUTBURST

### Believe Segal Has Wrong Slant on Palestine

Mr. Segal's attack on present Zionist policies which appeared in last week's issue of the Jewish Herald has invoked many of our readers to letters of protest and condemnation. Printed below is one of the many letters received.

—The Editors

Al Segal's stillborn outburst of cowardly "pragmatism" which appeared in your last issue is a bit of tommyrot which no self-respecting Jew worthy of the name would care to acknowledge. To say the very least, Mr. Segal has been guilty of extreme (loose thinking).

May I at the outset say that I am neither a politician nor a statesman in Zion. Until I was inspired by Al Segal's article, I had no connection with the Zionist movement.

I did not know that by preferring death by slow starvation, the God-given privilege of being a non-Ary in Germany, to death by a bullet in Eretz Yisrael was to be the more a "prophet of peace." Mr. Segal must realize that Palestine today is not an idle dream of imaginative Israelites, but rather a haven of refuge for martyred Jews. We do not care to be shot down by Arab bullets in Palestine but we do not dare to stop Jewish immigration to Palestine.

**Seeking Compromise**  
When Mr. Segal speaks of seeking peace and Armistice with Arabs, I am amazed at the profundity of his ignorance of facts. It is no longer open to question that the Jewish resettlement of Palestine has been of great benefit to the Arab population.

When the Jews bought land in Palestine they paid for it a price which before then was unheard of in the East. With the coming of the Jew have come thousands of Arabs to share in the benefits of Jewish development.

#### No Act of Reprisal

Yet, in spite of the unbridled pillage and wanton destruction of Arab hoodlums, in spite of their robbery and arson, their kidnappings and murders, not one of the four hundred thousand Jewish residents of Palestine has retaliated with a single act of reprisal! That, Mr. Segal, is grandeur in Israel unheard of in the world. What further olive branch does Mr. Segal require?

Mr. Segal should realize that Zionism does not mean a Jewish nation but rather a Jewish nationality. Zionism envisages a Jewish land populated in large part by Arabs. The Torah, True Jew knows that a Jewish nation

can only arise in Palestine, P'dai Shamayin.

By the cunning machinery of the culture created in Germany, by the cleverly executed starvation laws of Poland, by manifest anti-semitism on every side, we have earned and we may demand of right a land where we may dwell in complete peace and harmony. And by all history that land is Palestine.

#### No Armed Fighting

True, Israel is no warrior. "The hand is the hand of Esau, but the voice is the voice of Jacob." We need not fight with arms. We do not trust in horses, but we may and we must raise our voices in protest against injustice in Palestine.

Mr. Segal's attitude is typical of Sha-sha-Jews, who for centuries have sacrificed the rest of Israel that their own skins might be saved. Immigra-

tion into Palestine must not stop! Let us rather adopt the attitude of those Jews who say, "For every tree uprooted by an Arab, we will plant a thousand new trees."

The Highland Post, a newspaper published by one Will Flenk at Highland, N. Y., has come out with a story that will surely see the front page of every Nazi publication.

It is one of those sensations that by rights belong in a humorous magazine and that deserve no serious consideration. We mention it, however, because it is further evidence that the Hitler germ has infected a number of Americans who no longer can differentiate between plausible lies and fantastic fables.

The Highland Post presents a "scoop" from one of its correspondents who attended the "secret" convention of the American Zionists in Providence. There, right under the shadow of the statue of Roger Williams, the Jews of America, according to this correspondent, hatched a plot which will place Governor Lehman on the throne of America.

The author of this whole scheme is none other than Franklin Delano Roosevelt, who "in his hate and fear and sickliness has sold his Americans to the international plotters," is the story of this "great" Highland Post journalist.

The editor of the paper concludes his "expose" with urging "all true Americans: think fast, men; think fast, mothers of our America!" Lest some innocent souls suppose that the Highland Post is merely projecting this "plot" as a distant calamity set for the far-off future, the correspondent definitely sets this "revolution" to begin at 2 P. M. on September 15, 1936.

Incidentally, the story mentions that a young man by the name of Blumenthal shot a christian boy with a borrowed gun in Providence, as a preview of the "revolution."

We sincerely trust that no Jewish organizations will undertake any steps to silence the Highland Post. Such stories are more effective, we believe, in heaping ridicule on anti-Semitic activities in this country than anything we may do to counteract Hitler's poison.

In Legal Difficulties  
Upon the decease of its beloved Rabbi Abraham Pereira Mendes, the Congregation found itself in legal conflict with certain antagonistic and undoubtedly misinformed individuals, who sought by one means or another to close the portals of the ancient edifice against religious worship. Eventually the differences were to some degree adjusted, and worship in the Synagogue has continued practically uninterrupted to the present day.

Having in mind the value of a community building which would provide suitable quarters for a religious school and be a center of social and educational activities, steps were taken in 1913 to acquire suitable lands for the construction of such building thereon.

On December 1st, 1913, Honorable Mac Levy purchased from Annie Rogers the "Kodman House", so-called, located on Toussaint street, directly opposite the Synagogue, and held the same for the desired purposes until the General Assembly made suitable legislative provisions for taking it over from the accumulated and unexpended income of the Abraham Toussaint funds.

The old cemetery having been closed against future interments, the Congregation Israel, mindful of its obligation, acquired a new location for the burial of the dead, which has been inclosed by suitable walls and a gateway of permanent and pleasing design.

Though small in number the community has been ever mindful of its sense of responsibility, and has been responsive to the appeals of humanity, and to those institutions and movements which have been inaugurated from time to time for the betterment of all people of all creeds who whosoever they may be.

May we, as Americans by birth or adoption, ever maintain our love of country and be prepared at all times hereafter as in the momentous days of 1776, at New Orleans, Gettysburg, Gettysburg, San Juan and on Flanders Field be ready to make those sacrifices which have characterized those of the Jewish faith in the defense of our country and a continuation of its principles of justice and liberty.

As in the generations of the past, let us go on and on with our fellowmen in maintaining that relationship to each other which can and must only resolve itself into an understanding for the mutual betterment and advancement of all concerned.

### Nazis Seek to Censor Films in This Country

New York (WNS) — American movie actors who express anti-Nazi sentiments or participate in anti-Nazi gatherings will find themselves virtually forced out of the movies as a result of a Nazi order banning the showing of all films in Germany in which anti-Nazi actors, producers, writers, directors or others have had a part, it appears from a warning sent to Miss Isobel Steele by the German consul in Hollywood and made public here. Miss Steele, who spent four months in a German prison last year, is engaged in making a film.

### Costa Rica Jews Alarmed by Anti-Alien Drive

San Jose, Costa Rica (WNS)—A panic struck the small Jewish community of Costa Rica when the government issued instructions for an immediate census of all Poles, Chinese and Negroes. Since the term "Pole" in Latin America is generally used to describe Jews, the Jewish residents here fear that the census, which is designed to pave the way for deporting illegal immigrants, means that they will be expelled. Nazi propaganda and the complaints of native merchants who resent the competition of Jewish peddlars are believed to be behind this anti-alien drive.

A Musical Genius  
This news item might be entitled "A Child Protégé who grew up and made good." The principal of our story is Max Steiner who you remember is the internationally famous composer and conductor, who won the 1925 musical award given by the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. At the age of thirteen he established himself as a musical genius by finishing an eight year musical course in one year at the Imperial Academy, in Germany, where he was born May 10, 1888. During his year in the academy, he learned the finer points of the violin, piano, organ, cello and trumpet, and his exceptional brilliance and genius won for him a gold medal. His sixteenth birthday found him the roll of a professional conductor in Russia. After appearing in Moscow and Hamburg he went to England where a London theatre engaged him as conductor and orchestra leader. He was in London when the World War started and he faced the alternative of being interned or leaving the country to find residence in neutral territory. The young maestro decided to move to the United States, and landed in New York unheralded and apparently unwanted.

He was poverty stricken when he met Abie Erlanger, one of the outstanding music producers of the day, who assigned him to make the orchestral arrangement for "The Rainbow Girl." So well did he do this that offers of employment came from all sides. He found work as an orchestra leader and conductor with the late Florence Ziegfeld, Victor Herbert, George White and other famous figures in the theatrical and musical world.

Dinner for Berger  
Plans are practically completed for the testimonial dinner to be given for Dr. Eric Berger just prior to his sailing for Geneva and Palestine. Lues Reiter, prominent Jewish businessman and philanthropist, is also a delegate to the conference in Geneva. He and Dr. Berger will sail on the Queen Mary, Wednesday, July 29.

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## Moses Seixas Established First Bank in Newport

By Judge Max Levy  
Moses Seixas, son of Rabbi Isaac Mendes Seixas, although not so prominently and extensively engaged in the commercial life of Newport as those heretofore mentioned, he was nevertheless one of the most influential and respected citizens of the entire colony.

Remained in Newport  
Moses Seixas was numbered among the small group of Jews who remained in Newport after the British evacuation, and he participated to a marked degree in the restoration of the community spirit and its social and business life.

He established the Bank of Rhode Island, the first banking institution located in the City of Newport. It has continued to the present time under the name of the Newport Trust Company as a prominent and active banking center. From the time of its establishment to the death of Moses Seixas on November 2nd, 1809, he was its first and only cashier.

We have seen that the earlier Jewish immigrants are said to have brought with them certain degrees of Free Masonry. There is no doubt of the interest displayed by the Jews in the Masonic fraternity and in the establishment of King David Lodge, reputedly the first Lodge of Free Masonry in the Colony. It appears that on December 6th, 1768, Moses M. Case, Hayes, who was closely connected with the business and social life of Newport as well as of Boston, was appointed "by reason of his ferocity, contumacy and seal Deputy Inspector

General and Grand Master of and over all Lodges of the Royal Arch God—Elect—and Perfect Masons."

In addition to those mentioned there were many very prominent families who were recognized in the community for their contribution to its educational, commercial and social life. Among them reference may be had at this time to the families of Isaac Pol-

# Danzig Jews Panic-stricken As Nazis Stage Coup

Danzig (WNS) — Danzig Jewry found itself at the complete mercy of the Nazi-controlled government when the Nazi officials made public a series of decrees abolishing the constitutional guarantees of the League of Nations.

All Jewish organizations face immediate liquidation through a decree ordering the dissolution of all parties and societies whose members propagate "reports likely to endanger the state's interests."

The Nazis were also given carte blanche in the arrest and imprisonment of Jews and other enemies through a decree exempting police actions from judicial reviews, and permitting police to prevent any public meetings.

A special decree intended to "liber-

ate Danzig from the Jews" prohibits the practice of shechita. More decrees restricting Jewish rights are expected, and a mass exodus of Jews from the city has begun.

London (WNS)—Leaders of English Jewry are considering measures for the protection of the Jews of Danzig. A memorandum to the League of Nations is being drafted, calling on the League to take the necessary steps to protect the Jews of Danzig from Nazi revenge.
