## Tar, Feather Charge Made

Twelve Anti-Semites Face Superior Court

Santa Rosa—Charged with conspiracy, kidnapping and assault with deadly weapons, Attorney General Webb filed informations against 12 suspected vigilantes in the tar and feathering of two Jews in August of last year.

The defendants, described as "Fred Cairns et al." were brought to justice by the Attorney General after local authorities refused to take action.

Sol Nitzberg, Edward Wolfe, Silvia (Jack) Green, and Charles Mayer were mistreated, Nitzberg and Green being tarred and feathered.

Nitzberg told in court how he had been dragged from his farm home, beaten, tarred and feathered and warned to leave the country, by armed vigilantes, a year ago. He was accused, he said, of inciting farm workers to strike for higher pay.

Edward Wolfe testified that he was told by vigilantes to "get down on your knees, you Jew, and kiss the American flag." They accused him of being a "red" and a "Communist."

Wolfe named Fred Cairns, secretary of the Chamber of Commerce at Headsburg, as "captain" of the vigilantes.

Of the 21 defendants, Wolfe and other witnesses identified 13.

## European Folk-tales of Jewish Origin, Says Ginsberg

Cambridge, Mass. (WNS)—Some of the best-known folk-tales of medieval Europe are either of Jewish origin or have a good deal of Jewish ingredients, Prof. Louis Ginsberg of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America declared in a paper read at the Harvard tercentenary exercises. Reviewing the influence of Babylonia, Persia and Greece on Jewish folklore, Prof. Ginsberg said that "more important than the influence on foreign folklore on Jewish legendary lore is that exercised by the latter upon the biblical legends of Christians and Mohammedans."

## PERLMAN NAMED JUDGE

New York (WNS)—Nathan Perlman, who was appointed a city magistrate in 1935 by Mayor La Guardia, was promoted to the court of general sessions by the Mayor. Judge Perlman, a former member of Congress, is chairman of the administrative committee of the American Jewish Congress.

## Arabs Defy Great Britain Demand Complete Ind'pend'nce

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—Arab leaders defiantly replied to the British government's decision to send more troops into Palestine in order to quell the disorders with a manifesto demanding complete independence for Palestine and the liquidation of the mandate of the League of Nations under which Great Britain has administered the country's affairs since the end of the world war.

### Sharply Warned

The manifesto was issued following a meeting of the Arab Higher Committee, which had been sharply warned by High Commissioner Sir Arthur Wauchope to announce its stand on Britain's declaration for a strengthening of Palestine's armed forces and an intensification of the government's activities against betrayers and agitators responsible for the terror and violence that have disrupted

## POPE HITS NAZI WAR ON CHURCH

Rome (WNS)—Although the press is emphasizing Pope Pius' attack on Communism in his speech to a group of Spanish refugees, that speech also contains a vigorous if implied denunciation of Nazi persecutions of Catholicism.

"Without mentioning Germany by name the Pope said: 'The Catholic press is persistently suspected and increasingly hampered while every freedom and favor, or at least toleration, is shown to that press whose mission and purpose, it would seem, is to spread confusion among ideas, to mislead by falsifying facts, to bring the church into suspicion and to discredit ecclesiastical persons and things, Catholic teachings and institutions. It is a press that does not hesitate to proclaim a new Christianity and a religion of a new coinage.'"

## Jerusalem-Jericho Bridge Dynamited

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—Traffic between Jerusalem and Jericho has been cut off as a result of the dynamiting of the highway bridge linking the two cities. The successful bombing of the bridge followed a series of vain attempts made throughout the past week by Arab vandals.

## Arabs Bitterly Opposed

Asserting that the general strike was declared by the Arab people, "which have bitterly opposed Great Britain's policies under the League mandate during the past eighteen years, and not by the Arab Higher Committee, the Committee's memorandum states that it does not regard the appointment of the Royal Commission to investigate the causes of the disturbances "sufficient reason for stopping the strike."

It points out that previous commissions named to inquire into the grounds for earlier outbreaks did not succeed in bringing about a change of policy, and demands that a fundamental change be expressed in a stoppage of Jewish immigration, an issue which has been in the forefront of Arab agitation throughout the disorders.

Jacob I. The grounds of the home presents a carnival or circus atmosphere with a score of tents decorated with banners dotting the large area on Hillside Avenue. These booths will house the score or more departments from which thousands of dollars of valuable merchandise will be awarded every night.

Tex Max will personally direct the operation of the giant "bingo" booth with prizes of great value.

At the entrance of the grounds one will see the 1936 four door Oldsmobile sedan valued at nearly \$1000 which will be awarded as the feature prize. The committee this year has outdone itself in securing merchandise of much value and use and the carnival booths will be stocked full with everything one might imagine and all this merchandise will be brought home by hundreds.

## TWO ARAB KILLERS SENTENCED TO DIE

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—The first two death sentences meted out as a result of participation in the current disorders under the emergency regulations promulgated by High Commissioner Sir Arthur Wauchope were pronounced upon two Arabs convicted of shootings at British troops and wounding a soldier on August 7th. One of the Arabs confessed to the crime, saying that they had intended to kill Jews when they attacked a British convoy on the Tel Aviv-Hatza road.

A bomb hurled by an Arab at two Jewish workers transporting goods from a Jewish factory on the border of Jaffa to Tel Aviv severely wounded Abraham Biderman, 34, and slightly injured another Jew. Three Arabs, including a woman and a child, were reported killed, the latter two having been shot in an exclusively Arab district.

At least one Arab was killed when a military escort fired upon saboteurs who caused the derailment of a freight train near the Arab village of Kfar Jinnis on the Lydda-Haifa railway line.

## GUARD PROTECTS KING GEORGE TREE

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—Following an attack on the wood by Arab vandals, who destroyed 100 trees on the Nazareth hillside, a military guard of honor was placed around the tree from Windsor Castle which the late King George of England presented to the Jewish National Fund as the nucleus for the King George Jubilee Forest.

The Forest was inaugurated last year during the late English sovereign's jubilee, as a tribute of the Jews of Palestine to the service rendered by King George in the rebuilding of the Jewish National Home. Funds contributed by English Jews have built up the Forest on the previously barren hillside overlooking Nazareth.

## Roumanian Nazis Pick Vayda-Voivod as Premier

Bucharest (WNS)—Alexander Vayda-Voivod, one-time leader of the National Peasant Party and a former premier, will be the candidate of the United anti-Semitic and Fascist front for premiership in the event that Premier Georg Tatarescu is forced out of office. Vayda-Voivod was expelled from the National Peasant Party last year when he turned anti-Semitic.

## Maccabee Soccer Players Arrive Here from Palestine

New York (WNS)—Athletics has made such phenomenal progress among the Jews of Palestine that the country will not only be represented by a complete team in the 1940 Olympic Games in Tokyo but Jewish sportsmen from Palestine are counting on being a factor in soccer, water polo and boxing, was the message brought to America by the members of the Maccabee soccer team of Palestine.

The team has come here to play a series of games for the benefit of the Maccabee-Tel Aviv Sports Organization and the American Committee for the Relief of Polish Jews. A large crowd welcomed the Palestinian players upon their arrival in New York.

## Hitler Blasts Jews Again

Claims Bolshevism and Judaism Synonymous

Berlin (WNS)—Branding Bolshevism and Judaism as synonymous, Dr. Joseph Goebbels, Nazi minister of propaganda, and Dr. Alfred Rosenberg, Nazi party director for cultural policy, used the platform of the annual Nazi party congress at Nuremberg to call on the world for a last-ditch war against both Jews and Bolshevism.

In the most violent speech yet heard in Germany Goebbels cited the "effective" handling of Jews and Bolshevists in Germany and asked the world to join the Nazis in a crusade against both. Bolshevism, Goebbels said, is a "pathological and criminal type of madness devised by Jews, as can well be proved, and led by Jews who aim at destroying civilized nations and founding a world Jewish regime that would subject all nations to their power."

Warning that Bolshevism "constitutes a far-flung attempt by Jewry to obtain power over all nations," Goebbels said that "we can discuss this question frankly only in Germany, because elsewhere in the world it is a dangerous matter to mention Jews. There can no longer be any doubt that Bolshevism is the Jews' creation and that the Jews are its world-wide purveyors."

## Woman, 80, Would Let People Vote on War

New York (Special)—Still a crusader despite her years, Mrs. Flora Spiegelberg celebrated her eightieth birthday in the presence of three generations of descendants and reiterated her declaration that the only way to secure peace is to take away from governments the power to declare war and leave it to a referendum of the people.

She was a crusader when she was a bride back in the 70's, when she crossed the plains in a coach to join her husband in Santa Fe, N. M., the thirteenth white woman in that community, to help develop that city, and to count among her friends in those early days such well known figures as General Sheridan, General Grant, General Sherman, General Pope, President and Mrs. Hayes, and General Lew Wallace of "Ben Hur" fame.

She is still the crusader for the cause of peace and for New York city education. In the latter connection she invented a covered garbage cart for street cleaners and fitted it out at her own expense a \$ model. Only recently she marched in a peace parade.

What makes her "still so young at eighty?"

"Keeping active," she said.

### How Hitler Met His Death

 This is a historic document written fifty years hence. The grandson of the author of STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL records, in this column, stories of 1986.

—The Editor  
 For those of you who have never heard how Adolf Hitler died we here-with quote from the memoirs of his butler, who is still living in Zanzibar . . . "Adolf had been in power six years when he received a strange visitor at the Brown House. . . He was an old man of about ninety, all doubled up, with a tremendous hunchback . . . His long white beard reached almost to his navel. . . His hands were shaking and his eyes had the far-away look of a somnambulist. . . He insisted on seeing Der Fuehrer and gave his name as Rabbi Jeremiah ben Chochmah . . .

"Der Fuehrer was in a very good mood that day, having just received the news that the last Jew had left Germany. . . He received Rabbi Chochmah in the sumptuous parlor of the Brown House. . . I listened at the door to this strange conversation: Said the Rabbi: 'You have claimed during all these years that the Aryan race is the greatest and most powerful of mankind. . . You, as the leader of the Aryan race, are regarded as the mightiest of all human beings. . . I am a poor old, weak Rabbi. . . Yet I claim that I can defeat you in a duel provided you let me choose the weapons.' . . .

#### Adolf Is Willing

"Der Schoene Adolf smiled good-humoredly and said: 'I accept your challenge. What are the weapons?' . . . Rabbi Chochmah explained: 'Have two heavy chairs brought into this room. You will sit on one, Lon the other. . . Both of us will be tightly bound, so

that neither of us will be able to move. . . The doors of the room in which we will sit facing each other shall be locked for twenty-four hours. . . At the end of that time you will be defeated. . .

"I felt like going in and throwing this Jew out of the window, but Der Fuehrer, always ready for a joke at a Jew's expense, ordered us to bring in the chairs and to tie them both up according to Rabbi Chochmah's instructions. . . In accordance with the last instructions of the Rabbi, Der Fuehrer told us not to interrupt this session under any circumstances, regardless of what might happen and regardless of his own orders during the next twenty-four hours. . .

"I will never forget that night. . . The Rabbi, in a low, solemn voice, began to address Der Fuehrer. . . 'Herr Hitler, I consider you the lowest living creature. . . You are not only a degenerate but, according to all human and divine laws, the scum of the earth. . . Der Fuehrer's eyes must have bulged, and I could almost see his jugular vein ready to burst as raucous noises emanated from his throat. . .

#### Hitler Surprised

"I heard him shout: 'How dare you, you inferior non-Aryan being! I will have you shipped to a concentration camp and whipped till you plead for mercy.' . . . But Rabbi Chochmah continued in a low, unshaken voice: 'I am not afraid of you. Without your Brown Shirts and your murderous Gestapo you are small, weak and cowardly. . . You feel my superiority, and that is why you call for help.' . . .

"This was too much for me. . . I left the house, being afraid to disobey Der Fuehrer's orders by breaking into the room and smashing the impudent little Jew. . . I could hardly wait for the next day. . . Time passed so slowly that I felt the seconds stretching into hours. . . At six o'clock sharp I returned to the parlor and opened the door, ready to see the Rabbi destroyed by the divine power of Hitler. . .

"But I could not believe my eyes. . . Der Fuehrer, his chair overturned, but with him still tightly bound to it, lay motionless on the floor, while Rabbi Chochmah was fast asleep. . . Doctors pronounced the Fuehrer dead of apoplexy. . . This Elder of Zion had won the duel through some magic, and Germany was bereft of her great leader."

## Another New Year

As another year of Jewish history draws to its close the tragedy of the Jewish situation grows more appalling. Throughout Central and Eastern Europe the Nazi philosophy strides forward, crushing more and more of our brethren under its heel.

In Spain, hailed only a few years ago as a haven where some Jewish refugees from the Nazi terror could find asylum, an anti-Semitic Fascist dictatorship threatens.

In Palestine, the internationally recognized Jewish homeland, terrorism runs riot and violence essays to stop the return of Jews to their ancestral soil.

Even in the democratically governed countries, those in which Jewish citizens enjoy all the rights and privileges recognized as the due of any human being, anti-Semitism lurks in hidden places, awaiting an opportunity to pounce.

What the new year will bring none of us know, and only astrologers try to foretell. At this time one can say only that the horizon looks dark, heavy with war clouds. Europe is already shaken by the first warning gusts of the storm, and America, while unlikely to be embroiled in the conflict—which may come this year or next, but at any rate seems imminent—cannot possibly avoid feeling its effects.

As Jews and as human beings we must work toward that ancient Jewish ideal which so many peoples are choosing to ignore, unmindful of the fact that in the conflagration their own house will be consumed—the ideal of peace on earth.

**START WORK ON MILITARY CAMP**

**Jewish Labor to be Employed on \$300,000 Project**

Jerusalem (WNS-Palest Agency)—A contract for the erection of a \$300,000 British military camp near the Jewish settlement of Nathania has been awarded to the contracting bureau of the General Jewish Federation of Labor with only Jewish labor to be employed on the project, it is disclosed here.

Originally assigned to a firm of military contractors in Egypt, the contract was handed over by the latter to the Jewish Labor Federation, which must complete the job within two months.

The reports that the British cabinet had declined to suspend Jewish immigration into Palestine have brought differing reactions in the Arabic and Jewish press, with the latter apparently unimpressed by the news.

The Falastin, Arabic daily, says: "Let the English and Jewish press say what they will. We Arabs are awaiting the last word of Nuri Fasih Said Within a week." The reference is to the Iraqi foreign minister, who has been engaged for the past two weeks as mediator between the Arabs and the Palestine government.

**Ossip Gabrilowitsch Dead**

Famed Piano Virtuoso, 58, Was  
Married to Clara Clemens

Detroit, Mich. (WNS)—Ossip Gabrilowitsch, one of the world's most famous piano virtuosos, is dead here at the age of 58 after a long illness. In addition to being a celebrated pianist he was noted as a composer and conductor, and at the time of his death was the director of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, a post he had held since 1918.

Born at St. Petersburg, Russia, on February 8, 1878, young Gabrilowitsch showed musical talent at an early age. When he was nine the great pianist and composer Anton Rubinstein encouraged him to make music his career, and at 16 Gabrilowitsch graduated from the St. Petersburg Conservatory, the winner of the coveted Rubinstein prize.

His career as a concert pianist began in 1896 and after a number of triumphant European tours he came to America where he was so well received on numerous tours between 1900 and 1914 that he decided to make his permanent residence in this country. In 1909 he married Clara Clemens, daughter of the noted humorist Mark Twain, with whom he had one daughter, Nina.

In recent years Gabrilowitsch evinced a great interest in the development of Palestine, and was active in the movement to provide that country with its own music school and symphony orchestra.

**Italy Irked by Britain's  
Shift in Palestine**

Rome (WNS)—While the entire Italian press is voicing undisguised dissatisfaction at the failure of the British cabinet to halt Jewish immigration to Palestine and at its decision to take drastic steps to suppress Arab rioting, the Italian newspapers are reporting that Italy will send a delegation to the United States to seek financial aid from American Jews for the development of Ethiopia.

Among those mentioned in this connection is Leo Chertok who claims to have paid 1,000,000 for a concession to exploit Ethiopia's mineral wealth.

**JEWISH LABORERS  
SHOT FROM AMBUSH**

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—The toll of Jewish dead from Arab attacks during the current disorders was raised to 81 when Zecharia Yelet Abdar, 37, and David Malichi, 35, Yemeneite plantation laborers, were shot to death from ambush while working at night on an irrigation project in the Lurie orange grove near Ramleh.

The anxiety of the authorities to avert clashes in Jerusalem found expression in an order by District Commissioner J. E. F. Campbell extending the curfew here for another half hour; curfew hours now are from 6:30 P. M. to 6 A. M. The penalty for disregarding the curfew is a maximum of six months' imprisonment or a fine not exceeding \$400.

Death of Rabbi Schechter**

**Smears Bus With Swastikas;  
Convicted of Anti-Semitism**

Belgrade (WNS)—The highest court in Yugoslavia has convicted Dr. Kozjak, Nazi leader here, of insulting Yugoslavian Jews, spreading foreign propaganda and threatening Yugoslav citizens with a revolver. Kozjak was arrested on the complaint of a group of Jews who reported that while they traveled in a bus with him he had smeared the bus windows with swastikas, shouted anti-Semitic remarks at them and threatened to kill them. The high court, after two lower courts had failed to convict Kozjak, found him guilty and fined him 1,000 dinars.

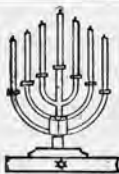

**MOVIE WORLD MOURNS THALBERG**

**"Boy Wonder", at 37, Had Achieved Great Success**

Hollywood, Calif. (WNS) — The movie world received a blow from which it will not soon recover when Irving Thalberg, executive production manager for Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer and generally acknowledged as the "boy wonder" of Hollywood, died suddenly at the age of 37.

A native New Yorker, Thalberg entered the movies in 1918, when he met Carl Laemmle, president of Universal Pictures.

Within two years Thalberg was general manager of Universal's studio. He was credited with the production of "The Hunchback of Notre Dame," "Outside the Law" and "Merry-Go-Round" before he was 25. His success brought him to the attention of Louis B. Mayer, who was then an independent producer.

Mayer took Thalberg into his organization and made him vice-president of the newly organized Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Company. In this post he reached the heights of movie success.

Among the stars he developed were Greta Garbo, Ramon Novarro, Lon Chaney, Joan Crawford, Wallace Beery, Robert Montgomery, Jean Harlow, Clark Gable, Myrna Loy and Norma Shearer. The last-named became his wife in 1927.

**BRITAIN WILL ABIDE BY MANDATE POLICY**

New York (WNS) — Replying to a cabled message from a group of Christian members of the Pro-Palestine Federation of America urging England not to deviate from the letter and spirit of the Palestine Mandate, Prime Minister Baldwin informed the Federation in a message conveyed through the British embassy in Washington that England has every intention of carrying out its obligations under the Mandate.

The message said: "On behalf of the Prime Minister we assure you that His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom have every intention of carrying out the obligation accepted in the Mandate to place Palestine under such political, administrative and economic conditions as will secure the establishment in Palestine of the Jewish National Home, while safeguarding the civil and religious rights of all the inhabitants of the country irrespective of race and religion."

**Marrano Jews Persecuted by Portugese Fascists**

Barcelona (WNS) — The Marrano Jews of Portugal are suffering persecution at the hands of Portugese Fascists and Fascist refugees from Spain, it is reported by the Jewish community here on the basis of reports received from Lisbon. 600 Marranos have fled from Braganza after an organized boycott and physical violence had made life unbearable for them, and all of them have taken up residence in Lisbon, the reports declare.

**CURES BONE AILMENTS**

Pittsburgh (WNS) — Discovery of allantoin, a drug obtained from the secretion of surgical maggots, as a successful treatment for bone diseases, gangrene, suppurating wounds and affected burns was announced at the annual meeting of the American Chemical Society by Dr. Frederick R. Greenbaum of Philadelphia.

**RABBIS ADVOCATE AVOIDING FASCISM**

**Believe Socialized Democracy Best Solution**

New York (WNS) — Expressing unrestrained opposition "both to the method of Communism and the regimentation of Fascism," the Social Justice Commission of the Central Conference of American Rabbis made public a Rosh Hashanah statement here in which it gives careful consideration to the "current conflict between Communism, Fascism and democracy" in "order that neither the young nor the old may be attracted to alien trends."

The statement expresses the conviction that "Judaism is essentially democratic in spirit and expression and that the Jew cannot advocate or advance any social system other than democracy." It also points out that the American people can only escape Communism and Fascism "by establishing a thoroughly socialized democracy" which can be achieved "without force and violence and bloodshed and through the orderly methods of democratic procedure."

Hollywood, Calif. (WNS) — Eddie Cantor's new fall radio program, which begins on Sunday, September 27th, will be devoted to a non-denominational discussion of the Bible. He will explain the Bible to Bobby Breen, his radio son.

**JEWES MUST PROVE FASCIST LOYALTY**  
Italian Press Asks for Definite Proof

Rome (WNS)—Anti-Semitism, long taboo in Fascist Italy, made its appearance in the official press when the Regime Fascista, organ of the Fascist Party, demanded that the Italian Jews "prove their loyalty to the Fascist party."  
"Cloaked in smooth words, the Regime Fascista publishes an article saying: "We must confess that the Jews of Italy, who are a minority, have intrigued in a thousand ways to gain posts in the world of Italian finance, economics and schools, but they have not opposed our onward Fascist march. We must confess they have always paid their debts, obeyed the laws, and discharged the duties of war; but they maintain an attitude which might arouse certain suspicions."  
"Why have they not uttered a single word which might persuade Italians they are fulfilling their duties as citizens for love, not for fear or profit? Why do they not demonstrate in some tangible way that they desire to break away from all the rest of the Jews in the world, whose ideal is the triumph of the Jewish international? Why have they not the Jews of Italy risen against members of their religion, destroyers of churches, sowers of hate and evil, and exterminators of Christianity? There is a growing impression that Europe shortly will be in the fever of a war of religion. Are they not aware of this? We are certain many will cry: "We are Fascist Jews." This is insufficient until they have given mathematical proof they are first Fascists and then Jews."

Heading what the correspondent calls an improvised civilian army, Menasse is said to be displaying great heroism as he leads his troops to battle. 25 years old, Menasse lived in France all his life until the civil war broke out in Spain, when he left his home to join the Spanish Loyalist forces in the fight against Fascism.

**Hear Lloyd George to Ask Nazis to Modify Decrees**

Berlin (WNS)—David Lloyd George, wartime prime minister of Great Britain, will endeavor to prevail upon officials of the Nazi regime not to enact any additional anti-Jewish legislation at the forthcoming Nazi party congress, it was learned from usually reliable sources. Mr. Lloyd George is now in Berlin to study Nazi methods of employment. From the same sources it was learned that the recent meeting between Premier Leon Blum of France and Dr. Hjalmar Selucht, German minister of economics, has led to certain unofficial negotiations looking to some modification of anti-Semitism in the Third Reich.

## Black Legion is Guerilla Band

### Grand Jury Reports Group is Not Fascist

Detroit, Mich. (WNS)—"Hysterical or unthinking action will not cure the curse of bigotry, prejudice and 'playboy' antics which lead adult men under the moon at night, in hood and robe, to tinker with the constitutional safeguards which our forefathers vouchsafed nearly 150 years ago," the Oakland County Grand Jury declared in a report denouncing the Black Legion as a politically ambitious guerilla band mentally incapable of wresting control from established authority.

The report, which coincided with the

opening of the trial of 12 members of the Black Legion for murder, named 86 State, county and city officials as members of the order.

Although the report said that "no evidence of criminality exists at the present time which will substantiate a criminal charge against the men named," their names were made public in the hope that "the light of publicity will effectively dispel enthusiasm for similar organizations, just as secrecy, darkness and ignorance further these sinister purposes."

Revealing that the national password "Lixto" was to be issued on September 16th to summon members of the Black Legion to action, the report says it is not known whether this action was to be a rebellion against the government or an effort to combat an alleged Communist revolt, but notes that "it is certain that the 'iron guard' was the inner unit recruited for duty in some extraordinary capacity, perhaps, as it is claimed, to take over government arsenals and powder magazines when the spark of revolution would inflame the land."

## PREDICT MARTIAL LAW IN PALESTINE

### Leaders Assert Policy is Four Months Late

Jerusalem (WNS-Palcor Agency)—The statement issued by the British Colonial Office announcing the sending to Palestine of an additional division of troops and the naming of Lieut. Gen. J. G. Dill as supreme military commander definitely "foreshadows the imposition of martial law" which will bring even "graver trials" to the Jews of Palestine, it was declared here by Moshe Shertok, head of the political department of the Jewish Agency for Palestine.

Welcoming the institution of stronger military measures in Palestine, the Jewish leader asserts that "the new policy is four months late but better than never."

Referring to the security prospects in the country, Mr. Shertok said: "There are graver trials in store for us, but we have no reason to repent our discipline in self-defense and our avoidance of retaliation which isolated and irresponsible outbursts did not succeed in breaking."

"We trust that the importance of our achievements with a self-restraint policy is fully appreciated by Jewry throughout the world."

"All our losses are the results of dastardly sniping from ambush but innumerable attacks are keeping our settlements under nightly fire which they are firmly resisting with vigorous self-defense. Not a single settlement has been penetrated; not a single Jewish position has been given up. We are holding our own throughout the country."

## MANY JAILED FOR TROTSKY ATTEMPT

Report Trotsky's Daughter and Husband Executed

London—The determined effort of the Soviet regime to purge the country of "Trotsky" elements reached the Stalin-dorf district, thickly populated by Jews. According to "Emes," leading Moscow Yiddish daily, many Jews were arrested in Stalin-dorf on the suspicion that they were sympathetic to Trotskyism.

The "Kurier Warszawsky," leading Warsaw daily, reports that Trotsky's daughter and her husband, whose name is Paslaw, were executed in Russia.

**Twelve More to Be Tried**  
 Twelve old communists, among them six Jews, will be tried in Moscow soon on the charge of secret attempts to overthrow the Soviet regime. The news reached here from private but reliable sources and is based upon news from Moscow Soviet circles.

The names of the accused are: Ger-tik, Greenberg, Gayon, Karev, Kuz-mitchoff, Konstant, Matorin, Esterman, Radin, Fairlovitch, Schmidt and Ald-berg.

Several of the men are prominently known in intimate party circles, but few of them are known outside of Russia. Two of these, Kuzmitchoff and Schmidt, are high ranking officers of the Red Army.

The charges against these twelve will be practically the same as against the sixteen defendants of the first trial who were later summarily executed. It is, therefore, very possible that although the present defendants are minor political personages they will share the same fate as the first defendants—death from a firing squad.

The G. P. U. continues its investigation of all suspected elements in the Trotsky movement and more sensational arrests are expected daily.

### Inventiveness of Playmates

Wins "Ginger" Rogers Her Name; "Swing Time" Held Over

Youthful nicknames seldom are appropriate after a child grows up. But "Ginger" Rogers' appellation fits her as well today as it did when it was first given her by her schoolmates in Fort Worth, Texas.

The rise of this slim youngster with the gold-red hair to a place among the first personalities of the screen is very largely due to the unusual quantity of spice in her makeup. It kept her doggedly at her dancing, and put an originality and freshness into that dancing, until she had won the Texas Charleston championship when she was only 15. ## ANCIENT JEWS WERE EXPERT SURGEONS

London—A recent archaeological discovery discloses the amazing information that the Jews in Palestine, nearly three thousand years ago, were expert surgeons. Three human skulls, now in the British Museum, clearly show that the Jews practiced trepanning, or the removal of a portion of bone in order to relieve pressure on the brain.

The published photographs of the skulls—all in excellent condition—show that the trepan used was a saw, that the incisions made were five, and that the piece of bone in each case removed was about 2.25 inches square. Dr. T. Wilson Parry writes in The London Times:

"The discovery is exceptional. Two of the skulls show a primitive operation that hitherto has only been found far away in Peru, the ancient land of the Inca and pre-Inca races. The dating of the Inca operations is uncertain, but it is certain that they were before—probably long before—the conquest of Peru in 1532.

"The hole in one of these skulls has a smooth and rounded edge. It can be judged that the bone was wounded and then completely healed, the owner of the skull recovering from his operation to die probably much later from some other cause.
